Collection Development Program Lead Librarian, August 2022 – present

- Team lead of the Learning Materials Budget Team (LMBT) (FY 23-25), a team of seven members comprised of representatives from four departments in the library. Directs discussions and votes on resource renewals, cancellations, and subscriptions and communicates about issues that potentially may affect the learning materials budget.
- Manage and prioritize collection development work and projects, including supervising four full-time faculty, one of whom supervises student employees.
- Manage the development of consistent methods for building collections to help internal and external users understand how we select materials and decide to cancel or weed resources.
- Coordinate weeding projects of print and online resources across the unit to ensure the collection comprises the most relevant materials.
- Lead the review of current and new resources to support diversity, equity, and inclusion in our collections to ensure our collections represent views and perspectives of the campus community. This has included advocating for the purchases of ethnic studies databases; allocating funds to purchase older books related to ethnic studies, gender studies, and social justice in ebook format; and supporting the review of books with outdated language.
- Lead the promotion of library collections through online and physical displays, news articles, communication, and collaboration with groups on campus.
- Designed and implemented a survey to assess the perspectives of students, faculty, and staff on the library's collections and access to the collections.

- Led the coordination of, decision-making, and communication about the cancellation of \$508,000 of resources, 13.9% of the learning materials budget. Organized the collection of usage and cost statistics, analyzed resources for diverse content, reviewed vendor ethics' profiles, and gathered feedback from almost 400 users on potential cancellations. Developed a comprehensive communication plan to ensure internal and external users were aware of the process and final decisions.
- Created critical documentation to help new and current employees become successful in taking on new roles or responsibilities. These include a collection development manual outlining expectations and projects, comprehensive onboarding plan for new collection development librarians, training and expectations document for new student employee supervisors, support and safety overview, and collection development vision and priorities.

Scholarly Communication & Collection Development Program Lead, Dec. 2020 – July 2022
Researcher Support Librarian, August 2014 – November 2020

- As Lead managed the work of the scholarly communication and collection development group, which comprised of four faculty. Supervised 2-3 faculty directly.
- As Lead, led scholarly communication and collection development projects which involved assigning tasks and deadlines for projects; coordinating with heads and members of other library departments; developing and supporting new initiatives; and promoting resources, services, and knowledge both internally and externally.
- Directed the development, promotion, and teaching of research workshops, including data management, EndNote, poster design, impact factor, copyright, and others. Entailed coordinating groups to create learning outcomes, lesson plans, handouts, presentation slides, online guides, and supplementary learning materials. Workshops help faculty, staff, and students develop new research skills to support their teaching, learning, and research.
- Managed LibGuides, an online research guides platform, for the entire library by organizing guide analysis, updates, and revisions. Created LibGuides Standards to ensure guides meet basic accessibility and quality.
- Reviewed and selected materials for social science and humanities collections.
- Provided research assistance in-person, over the phone, via email, and via chat.
- Designed and taught information literacy sessions in-person and online with unique student learning outcomes relevant to course requirements.
- Managed and coached student assistants including selection, training, mentoring, project development, and performance management.
- Led the development, delivery, and analysis of a survey to assess research needs of faculty and graduate students. Results helped develop research workshops and create new positions based on campus needs.
- Coordinator for the federal and Colorado state document collections including overseeing the processing of new materials and withdrawal of older material, collecting and analyzing usage data of government materials, and coordinating with other depository libraries.
